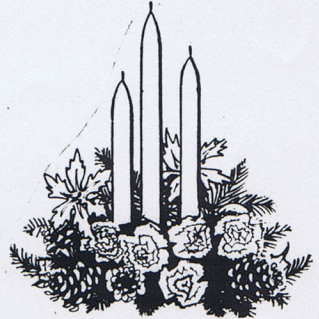

Now into its second volume, the "Gulf Coast Historical Review" is making an important contribution to the study and preservation of the history and genealogy of the area it covers.

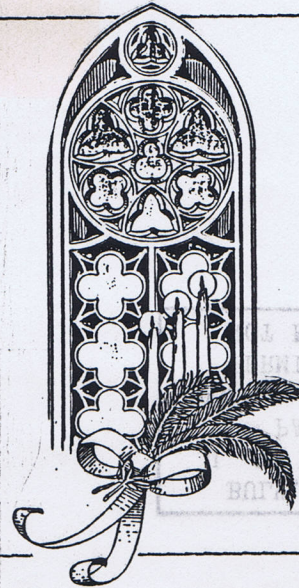
Published biannually by the History Department of the University of South Alabama, the magazine is under the managing editorship of Dr. Michael Thomason.
