Attendance has been great at our past two or three meetings, and let's keep it up!

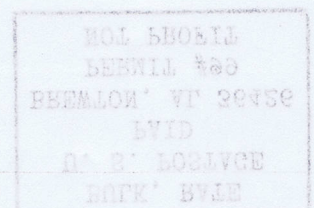
We had a packed meeting room for our program on Alco United Methodist Church, and Trish Hart gave a fine program, with a number of those present also sharing interesting information about Alco.
