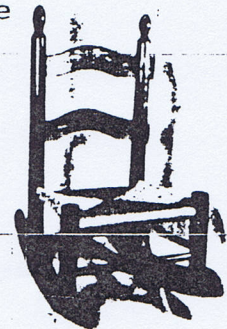
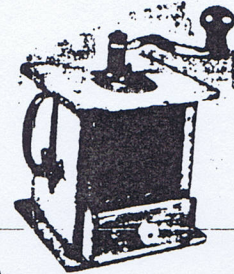
MEETING: TUESDAY, OCT. 23, 1990
