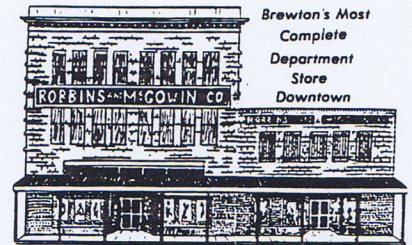
MEETING: Tuesday, August 25, 1992

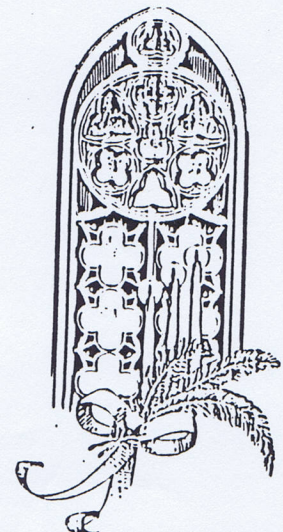
