## REMEMBER OUR COLLECTION!

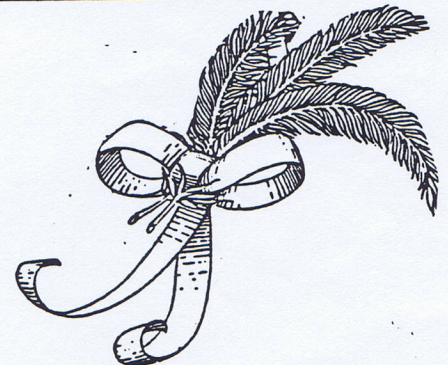
