BREWTON, ALABAMA -- A report from the coroner's panel jury in a shooting: "We the jury empaneled to enquire into the causes and death of Bob Toomer have received the body and thoroughly examined the witnesses, and from this evidence find that the deceased came to his death from the result of a pistol wound inflicted by E.S. McMillan, sheriff of Escambia County. We further find that the sheriff held three warrants of arrest and was attempting to serve them. The deceased resisted arrest and attacked the sheriff, who fired in self defense.
