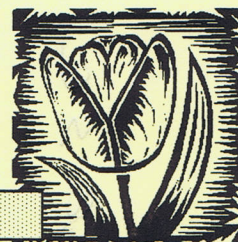

### **GOOD NEWS!**

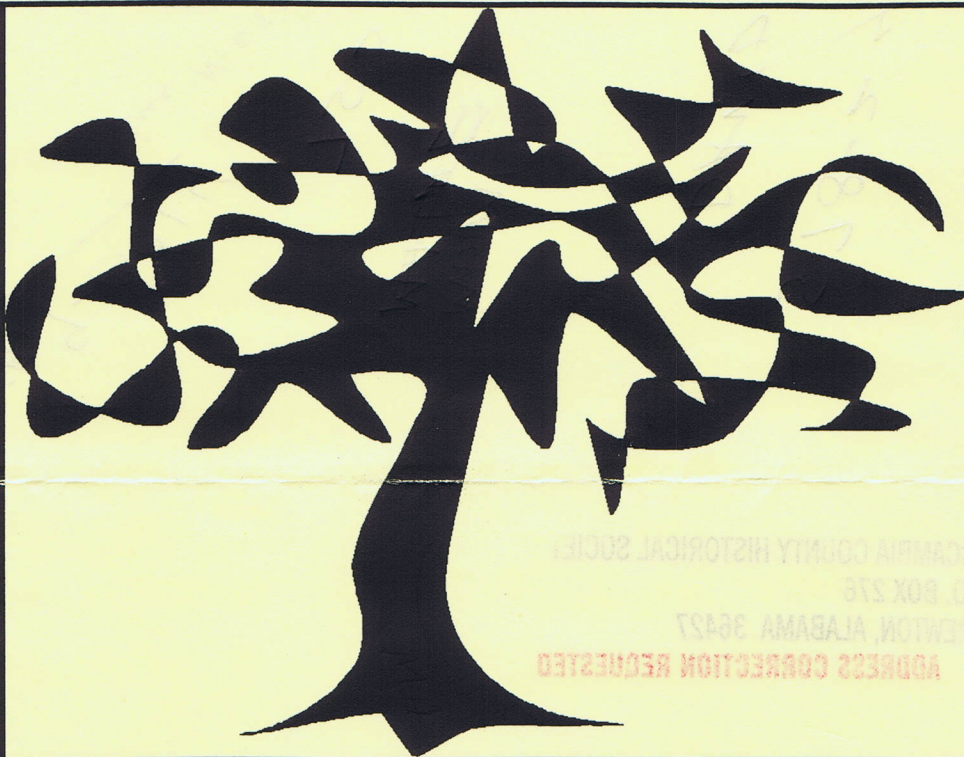
Mrs. Catherine Brooks is back at her home on Bellville Avenue. Welcome home from all of us Mrs. Brooks!
